READ AND CHECK YOUR ANSWERS.

Dinosaurs **were** reptiles. They lived on Earth between 200 million and 65 million years ago. The word Dinosaur comes from two Greek words: *deinos* = terrible and *sauros*= lizard. **There were** many kinds of dinosaurs. The most famous are: tyrannosaurus, triceratops, brachiosaurus, stegosaurus and the iguanadon. Humans and dinosaurs never lived together.

The T-Rex **was** the most dangerous dinosaur. It **had** four legs and it **moved** very quickly. It **was** a meat-eater and it **killed** other dinosaurs. Its teeth **were** about fifteen centimetres long. The Tyrannosaurus **lived** about 65 million years ago.

The triceratop **had** three horns and a big plate round its neck to protect it from carnivorous dinosaurs. It **was** a plant-eater. It **lived** about 70 million years ago.

The Brachiosaurus **was** one of the biggest dinosaurs. It **had** a very long neck and four legs. It **ate** plants and leaves every day, maybe thousands of kilos. The brachiosaurus **lived** about 140 million years ago.

The Stegosaurus **lived** about 140 million years ago, too. It **ate** plants. It **had** plates on its back and spikes on its tail. When carnivorous dinosaurs appeared, the stegosaurus hit them with the spikes.

The Iguanadon **ate** plants. It usually moved on two legs and it **had** two hands. It **had** spikes on its hands. It **lived** about 115 million years ago.

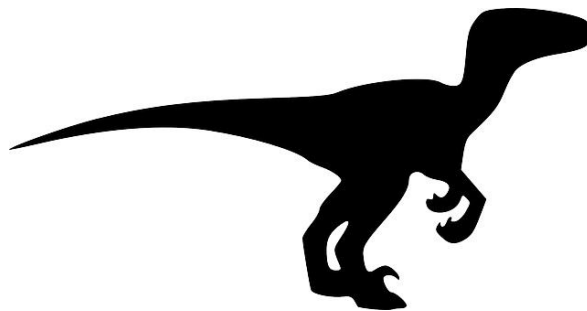
